The program was organized in light of the UN Secretary General's call on the need for inclusive and networked multilateralism to coordinate with various regional, governmental and non-

governmental institutions for the public good, building hope and trust and reconstruct relations between people. The envisages offering the grocery ration kit with all bare food essentials to one hundred families in the first phase. The school authorities carefully handpicked the families who were hit hard by continuous lockdown with the support of local government representatives. The actual distribution of the In-Kind Contributions will be done by the emergency-distribution centre of the local-government only ones permitted to distribute to the needy during lockdowns.
